May I have your attention please? The Peninsula Amateur Radio Emergency Team Net will begin in two minutes. This is [your call sign and location], net control.

<TX'd at 7:00pm.>

Hello and welcome. This is net control station [your call sign and location] calling the roll for the Peninsula Amateur Radio Emergency Team Net, serving the Gig Harbor / Key Peninsulas and neighboring areas. This net meets every Monday at 1900 hrs. local time on the W7ZLJ 145.350 mhz. repeater with a backup simplex frequency of 146.560 mhz. The purpose of this net is to promote emergency communications, inform members of local and state activities, and provide training in a formal net.

All other stations please stand by for roll call.

<CONDUCT ROLL CALL>

<Even number days, start at top of roster, odd number days, start at bottom>

That completes the roll call. Are there any late or missed stations would like to check in?

Are there any visiting stations would like to check in?

Is there any further business for the Peninsula Amateur Radio Emergency Team Net?

In the event of an emergency members are encouraged to monitor this frequency and take all appropriate steps to provide and support emergency communications. We encourage everyone to check in to the Pierce County Amateur Radio Emergency Services Net on Tuesdays at 1900 hrs. on the W7AAO 145.370 mhz. repeater.
