

**QST QST QST THIS IS <CALL SIGN> IN ROY, WASHINGTON, CALLING THE ROY AREA COMMUNICATIONS NET.**

**THIS NET MEETS ON FRIDAY AT 1900 HOURS LOCAL TIME ON 147.42 SIMPLEX.**

**THE ROY AREA COMMUNICATION NETWORK IS AFFILIATED WITH WESTERN WASHINGTON DISTRICT 5 AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICES, COMMONLY KNOWN AS ARES,**

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS NET IS TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN COMMUNICATION CAPABILITIES THROUGHOUT THE ROY AREA IN SUPPORT OF THE ARES EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION MISSION.**

**THIS IS <CALL SIGN> MY NAME IS <NAME> , NET CONTROL FOR TONIGHT'S ROY AREA NET.**

**ARE THERE ANY STATIONS WITH EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC?**

**ARE THERE ANY RELAYS?**

**THIS IS A DIRECTED NET. ALL AMATEURS WITH AN INTEREST IN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION ARE INVITED TO CHECK IN.**

**FIRST WE TAKE REGULAR ROY AREA NET MEMBERS, FOLLOWED BY VISITORS**

**PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR FULL CALL SIGN, NAME AND LOCATION.**

**FOLLOWING INITIAL CHECK-INS, I WILL RETURN TO EACH STATION LOGGED IN FOR ANY ANNOUNCEMENTS, QUESTIONS, COMMENTS, OR DISCUSSION TOPICS.**

**THIS IS <CALL SIGN> NOW CALLING FOR REGULAR ROY AREA NET MEMBER CHECK-INS:**

*Consider the Eatonville crew "Regular" since they are normal check-ins*

*Pause: Net Control notes check-ins, and proceeds as follows:*

**THIS IS NET CONTROL <CALL SIGN>. I HAVE THE FOLLOWING STATIONS LOGGED-IN:  
<CALL SIGN> <CALL SIGN> <CALL SIGN> AND <CALL SIGN>.**

**THANK YOU ALL FOR CHECKING IN.**

**DO WE HAVE ANY LATE OR VISITOR STATIONS WISHING TO CHECK IN? PLEASE GIVE YOUR CALL SIGN, NAME AND LOCATION.**

*Pause; Net Control acknowledges late and visitor check-ins and then proceeds:*

THIS IS NET CONTROL <CALL SIGN> OPENING THE NET FOR ANNOUNCEMENTS, COMMENTS, QUESTIONS OR DISCUSSION TOPICS, BEGINNING AT THE TOP OF THE LIST,  
<FIRST CALL ON THE CHECK IN LIST>  
DO YOU HAVE ANYTHING FOR THE NET TONIGHT?

*Pause: When all topics have been covered and/or all have had an opportunity to comment, Net Control proceeds:*

DO WE HAVE ANY LATE OR ADDITIONAL STATIONS WISHING TO CHECK IN TO THE ROY AREA COMMUNICATION NET?

*Pause, If yes, Log them in, if not, Close Net as follows:*

*(Here, if we intend to routinely run a post net HF frequency checks, announce the band and frequency, Net Control having prior to the net selected/determined a usable frequency.)*

FOR INTERESTED STATIONS, WE WILL OPEN AN INFORMAL, QSO ON

STATIONS WISHING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INFORMAL POST NET HF DISCUSSION AND SYSTEM CHECK, PLEASE ADVISE NOW, STAND BY ON THIS FREQUENCY 147.20 AND TUNE TO HF \_\_\_\_\_ METER BAND \_\_\_\_\_ FREQUENCY \_\_\_\_\_.

THIS IS NET CONTROL <CALL SIGN> NOW CLOSING THE ROY AREA COMMUNICATION NET.

*Pause: If there is interest, Net Control may dispatch one station to select an open HF Band and Frequency while the others stand by on 147.42 until a suitable Band and Frequency have been identified.*

*Net control reminds participants that the HF exercise is an informal rag-chew QSO and is not a net; Each station assumes responsibility for compliance with FCC amateur radio service rules and protocols, e.g. ID, Sign Off, etc.*
